We joined forces with an esteemed partner. To create greater possibilities for men and women facing homelessness in Chicago, Inspiration Corporation and The Employment Project carefully planned and executed a merger. The Employment Project is an 11-year-old organization that brings its Chicagoans make vital connections. We created two new facilities that opened in October 2005. Inspiration Corporation completed renovations at our new site for The Living Room Cafe at 806 E. 64th St., to better serve homeless adults and children in Woodlawn, with private offices for case management and significantly improved facilities. And we readied our new Cafe Too restaurant and training facility at 4715 N. Sheridan Rd. in Uptown, where we welcome the public
